Our university is focus on accrediting the different academic programs in the different colleges either by local accreditations or by international accreditations. The main objectives—is to accredit the academic programs that will meet standards of quality education, to strengthen and further improve the quality of our program to the level of our ASEAN neighbors, to become a resource to strengthen other schools in our localities, and lastly, to consults and assists in the development and advancement of education worldwide. The end result of all—these accreditations is to foster the international recognition of the Chemical Engineering Program of DLSU and the qualifications of our graduates. The Chemical Engineering Program of DSLU was awarded the Center of Development (COD) by the Commission on Higher Education—(CHED) in the Philippines and Level IV accreditation by the Philippine Accrediting of Schools, Colleges and Universities (PAASCU). We are now preparing the self-study documents for the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) which is a US based non-profit and non-governmental accrediting agency for academic programs in the disciples of applied science, computing, engineering and engineering technology. Lastly, we plan to apply to the Philippine Technological Council (PTC) accreditation which has a provisional membership to the Washington Accord.
